The dark green color and desirable leaf density of Prelude III make it a popular choice for golf course superintendents. It's intended for golf course greens, tees, and fairways in cool season climates and winter overseeding in the southern states. It exhibits a slower and lower growth for a cleaner cut and good winter hardiness. Prelude III is extremely wear tolerant and is endophyte enhanced for natural insect resistance. This versatile grass is great for golf course use by itself or in a blend.

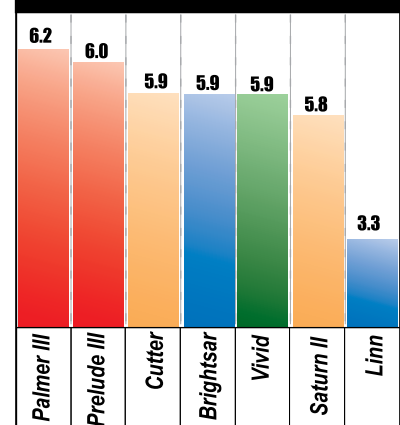


PERENNIAL RYEGRASS
